

KIDSPORTS 3v3 Civic Park Hoopfest Important Information

- **Check-in** will begin 15-20 minutes before the first game at the North Entrance of the Kidsports Field House (2054 Amazon Parkway Eugene, Oregon). The head coach or captain will be able to take all of the T-Shirts for the team.
- **Face masks and face coverings:** When indoors, all coaches and spectators are required to wear a face covering unless they are vaccinated. Spectators under 12 years old are encouraged to wear a mask indoors but not required. Unvaccinated players are encouraged to wear a face covering, but it is not required. Social distancing should be maintained when possible.
- **Hand hygiene:** handwashing facilities, tissues and garbage receptacles will be easily accessible.
- **Ventilation** systems (e.g. HVAC) will be operating at full capacity to increase circulation of outdoor air as much as possible through open windows and doors and using fans and other methods where possible.
- **Cleaning and disinfection:** High-touch/highly frequented surfaces and spaces will be cleaned and sanitized frequently (for example, bleachers, bathrooms, water filling station etc.).

Additional Info:

- **All teams will be responsible for their own game jersey with numbers.** In the event two teams have the same color, pinnies will be available at the scoring table.
- **Games** will be played on Court 1 (North) and Court 2 (South) in the fieldhouse gym.
- Teams must sit in the designated team bench area. Parents and spectators will not be allowed on or around the bench area.
- Kidsports will provide a timekeeper/scorekeeper for all games.
- **Pool play tie breakers** will be awarded first to teams with sportsmanship status with regards to technical fouls followed by the combined lowest amount of points allowed by each team.
- There will be an outdoor warm up area for teams and spectators that are waiting for their game to begin. This area will be marked with signage once inside the facility.
- **Sportsmanship is a part of the experience and expected.** Players, coaches, parents and spectators are expected to uphold the same standards of sportsmanship when conducting themselves toward other teams, officials and Kidsports staff.
- By entering the KS Fieldhouse you agree to the expectations stated below in the KS parent and spectator guidelines. Failure to comply with parent/spectator guidelines has as a consequence, removal from the facility.
